

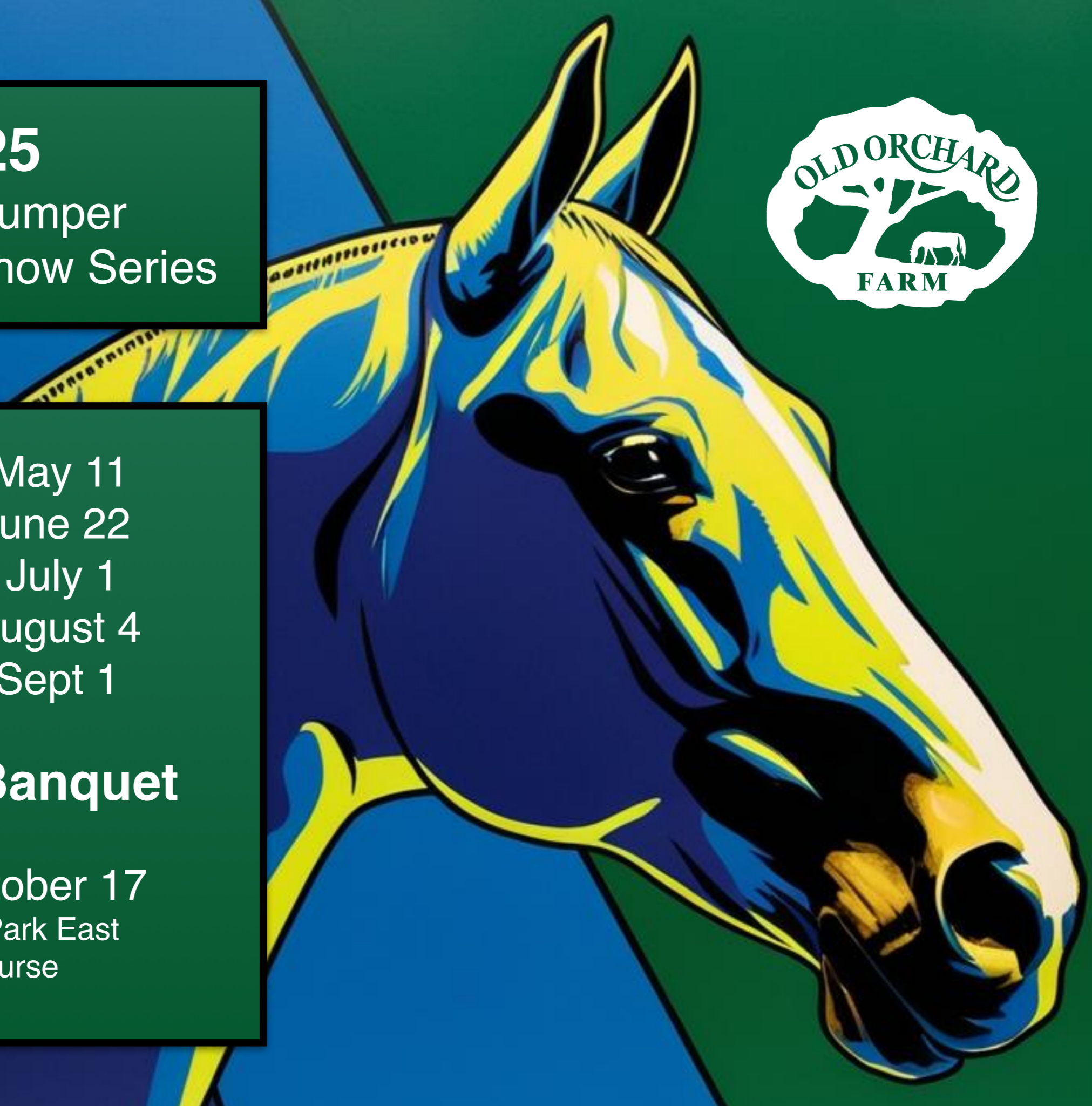

# Eligibility

## Division Requirements

Horse and rider combinations who have shown at recognized competitions (EC Silver and above) must compete one division up from what they have shown at a recognized level. Riders are not eligible to ride in the equitation division if they also ride that division at EC Silver level or above.

We will make an exception for the competitors who "sampled" showing at a recognized level (either at only 1 show or without winning a ribbon) and decided it was not yet for them.

Horse and rider combinations who have been year end champion in a division at our show series are not eligible to show the same horse/rider combination in the same division the following year or after.

Division points are calculated based on horse/rider combination.

Horse/Rider combinations must compete in the same division at 3 out of 5 shows to be eligible for year end awards, except for equitation divisions where riders must still compete in 3 of 5 shows but are not required to ride the same horse/pony.

The Hack Division is open to horses and ponies.

Equitation Divisions (Ages as of Jan 1, 2025):

Junior 'A' - A rider who is 15, 16, or 17 on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

Junior 'B' - A rider who is 12, 13, or 14 on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

Junior 'C' - A rider who is under 12 on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

Adult equitation riders must be amateurs.

Professionals are welcome to ride in any Jr/Am division at our concours.

All special classes are open to all Jr/Am's and professionals including those who show EC Silver or above.

# Important Notes

## Warm Ups:

Free flat warm up is offered in all show rings between 7:00AM and 8:00AM.

Paid “ticketed” hunter warm up (for the first divisions) begin at 8:00am in the West and Lower Sand Rings and conclude just before classes begin at 9:00am. There are opportunities for paid “ticketed” warmup before each division in those rings. Register for warm up online with your regular show entry.

Ticketed hunter warm up entitles the ticket bearer to ONE trip around the course only. Please be as quick and efficient as possible.

Clear round classes are offered in the Jumper Ring in lieu of ticketed warm up.

Upper Grass Ring is available for flat warm up only until Beginner divisions are complete, at which time the first judge finished in their regular ring will relocate to the grass ring for the Open Special Classes (not to begin before noon).

Indoor Arena will open for general warm up following the lead line division.

## Rings:

Old Orchard Farm reserves the right to change the schedule or ring that a division will run in depending on class numbers and to keep the day running smoothly.

Over fences classes may run back to back to keep the day running smoothly and efficiently.

## Entries:

Entries are due at midnight 2 days before the show. Entries posted after this date will be subject to a **post entry fee of \$2.00 per class.**

Day of entries are allowed but will be subject to post entry fees above.

HST is included in Entry and Administration Fees.

## Prizes:

Ribbons to 6th place in all classes except where stated otherwise.

Champion & Reserve Champion Awarded in all divisions except lead line.

Prize money where applicable is paid in cash at the time of placing.

In the case of a tie for champion or reserve, points accumulated over fences will hold more weight than points won under saddle.

## Show Day Information:

Food booth on site.

Jackets will be excused across the show if and when temperatures exceed 28 degrees C.

In the case of lightning, classes will be held until weather settles.

# Biosecurity Protocols

## For Show Day at OOF

Please check all attending horses temperatures the night before and the morning of the horse show. Resting temperature should not be above 38.6 C (101.5F)

If ANY horses at your barn, showing or non showing, has a higher than normal temperature, please do NOT bring ANY horses to the show at Old Orchard Farm.

Please do NOT bring any horses with runny noses, a cough or other symptoms of illness to the show.

Please do NOT enter barns, particularly with outside horses (except indoor arenas). A water bucket filling station will be made available for outside use.

Please do NOT allow horses to touch noses or share buckets or equipment with horses from other barns.

### TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR HORSE AWAY FROM HOME

- 1 Bring your own tools and water buckets and don't share! 
- 2 Bring your own grooming and bathing tools. 
- 3 When filling water buckets do not submerge the hose in the water. 
- 4 Clean and disinfect your boots before entering your horse's stall after returning from the manure pile. 
- 5 Make sure your horse's vaccinations are up to date.

# Special Awards

Special awards are presented at our annual year end awards banquet. To arrive at our points, we multiply placing points by the number of riders in the class. Rider must have shown in 3 of the 5 shows to qualify for year end awards.

## Good Grooming Award

This is a cumulative award given to the rider in either of the junior beginner divisions who has earned the most Good Grooming awards throughout the regular show season. This award shows that winner shows attention to detail and reverence for the traditions of our sport.

## Sportsmanship Award

## Erika Lamb Equitation Award

### Sponsored by the Lamb Family

This award honours a young OOF rider whose passion for animals and equitation are second to none. This award is presented to the rider who has accumulated the highest number of points across all of the equitation classes during the regular show season. This award includes entry into the annual I Ride 4 Erika Equitation Clinic hosted by Old Orchard Farm.

## Just Keep Swimming High Point Jumper Award

In Honour of a very special equine partner and jumper extraordinaire - Of All the Fish in the Sea. This award is presented to the horse and rider combination who accumulate the most points in any jumper class and/or division throughout the season.

## Field Master Trophy

The Field Master Trophy goes to the horse or pony who has the most cumulative points throughout the entire year. ## South Lake Rusty Stirrup Award

## High Point Trainer Award
