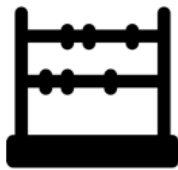

# Eligibility

## Division Rules

Horse and rider combinations that have competed at recognized competitions (EC Silver level or above) must enter one division higher than the level at which they have previously shown.

Riders are not eligible to compete in an equitation division if they are also competing in that same division at EC Silver level or above.

An exception may be made for competitors who have only “sampled” recognized competitions, for example attending a single show or competing at the level without earning a top-three placing, and have determined they are not yet ready to continue at that level.

Horse and rider combinations that have been Year-End Champion in a division within our show series are not eligible to compete in that same division with the same horse/rider combination in subsequent years.

## Points & Year-End Awards

Division points are calculated based on the horse and rider combination, with the exception of equitation, which is judged on the rider only.

To be eligible for year-end awards, horse and rider combinations must compete in the same division at a minimum of three out of five shows.

For equitation divisions, riders must still compete in three out of five shows but are not required to ride the same horse or pony.

## Divisions & Eligibility

The Hack Division is open to both horses and ponies.

**Equitation Divisions** (ages as of January 1, 2026):

- **Junior A:** Riders aged 15 to 17
- **Junior B:** Riders aged 12 to 14
- **Junior C:** Riders under 12
- **Adult:** Riders aged 18 and above, must be amateurs.

Professionals are welcome to ride in Junior/Amateur divisions *hors concours*.

Special classes are open to all riders.

# Important Notes

## Warm-Ups

Free flat warm-up is available in all show rings from 6:00 AM to 7:00 AM.

Paid, ticketed hunter warm-up for the first divisions begins at 7:00 AM in the West Ring and Lower Sand Ring and runs until just before classes start at 8:00 AM. Additional ticketed warm-up opportunities will be offered prior to each division in those rings. Warm-up tickets must be purchased online with your regular show entry. Additional tickets can be purchased in the office.

Each ticket entitles the rider to one trip around the course only. Riders are asked to be efficient and keep warm-up rounds brief.

In the Jumper Ring, clear round classes will be offered in place of ticketed warm-up.

The Upper Grass Ring is available for flat warm-up only until the Beginner divisions are complete. At that time, the first available judge will move to the Grass Ring for Open Special Classes, which will not begin before 12:00 PM.

The Indoor Arena will open for general warm-up following the beginner equitation division.

## Rings

Old Orchard Farm reserves the right to adjust the schedule or relocate divisions between rings as needed to accommodate class sizes and ensure the day runs efficiently.

Over fences classes may run back-to-back to maintain a smooth schedule.

## Entries

All entries must be completed online at: <https://www.showmanagementsystem.com>

Entries close at midnight, two days prior to the show. Entries submitted after this deadline will be subject to a post-entry fee of \$2.00 per class.

## Entries

Day-of entries are permitted but will be subject to the post-entry fees as a outlined.

HST is included in all Entry and Administration fees.

## Prizes

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place in all classes unless otherwise stated.

Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in all divisions except lead line.

Prize money, where applicable, will be paid in cash at the time of placing.

In the event of a tie for Champion or Reserve Champion, over fences points will take precedence over under saddle points.

## Show Day Information

A food booth will be available on site.

Jackets will be waived across all divisions when temperatures exceed 28°C.

In the event of lightning, classes will be paused until conditions are safe to continue.

## Acronyms & Terms

- **O/F** – Over Fences
- **U/S** – Under Saddle
- **Jr.** – Junior (under 18 as of January 1, 2026)
- **Am.** – Amateur (non-professional, 18 and over as of January 1, 2026)
- **Eq.** – Equitation

**Open Card Equitation:** Riders compete over fences at their regular division height as an additional (third) over fences class within their division.

# Biosecurity Protocols

## For Show Day at OOF

Please check all attending horses temperatures the night before and the morning of the horse show. Resting temperature should not be above 38.6 C (101.5F)

If ANY horses at your barn, showing or non showing, has a higher than normal temperature, please do NOT bring ANY horses to the show at Old Orchard Farm.

Please do NOT bring any horses with runny noses, a cough or other symptoms of illness to the show.

Please do NOT enter barns, with outside horses (except indoor arenas).

Please do NOT allow horses to touch noses or share buckets or equipment with horses from other barns.

### TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR HORSE AWAY FROM HOME

- 1 Bring your own tools and water buckets and don't share! 
- 2 Bring your own grooming and bathing tools. 
- 3 When filling water buckets do not submerge the hose in the water. 
- 4 Clean and disinfect your boots before entering your horse's stall after returning from the manure pile. 
- 5 Make sure your horse's vaccinations are up to date.

# Special Awards

Special awards are presented at our annual year end awards banquet. To arrive at our points, we multiply placing points by the number of riders in the class. Rider must have shown in 3 of the 5 shows to qualify for year end awards.

## Good Grooming Award

This is a cumulative award given to the rider in either of the junior beginner divisions who has earned the most Good Grooming awards throughout the regular show season. This award shows that winner shows attention to detail and reverence for the traditions of our sport.

## Sportsmanship Award

## Erika Lamb Equitation Award

### Sponsored by the Lamb Family

This award honours a young OOF rider whose passion for animals and equitation are second to none. This award is presented to the rider who has accumulated the highest number of points across all of the equitation classes during the regular show season. This award includes entry into the annual I Ride 4 Erika Equitation Clinic hosted by Old Orchard Farm.

## Just Keep Swimming High Point Jumper Award

In Honour of a very special equine partner and jumper extraordinaire - Of All the Fish in the Sea. This award is presented to the horse and rider combination who accumulate the most points in any jumper class and/or division throughout the season.

## Field Master Trophy

This award honours a past OOF school horse who helped launch the show careers of an extraordinary number of riders. The Field Master Trophy goes to the horse or pony who has the most cumulative points throughout the entire year. Over the years, this award has been won both by a horse or pony showing with one rider or with multiple riders.

Esprit was the first show horse for many, many riders. She ended up with 2 passports as her first one got filled up. This trophy goes to the rider in any beginner division who has the most points at the end of the season.

## South Lake Rusty Stirrup Award

## High Point Trainer Award

## Awards Banquet

All competitors are invited to attend the year end awards banquet. Horse/Rider combinations must compete in the same division at 3 out of 5 shows to be eligible for year end awards, except for equitation divisions where riders must still compete in 3 of 5 shows but are not required to ride the same horse/pony.
